Summary:

Ministerial Directives

Overall there is an excellent level of documented compliance with most Ministerial Directives with the following exception:

There was no documentation of either officer having received and understood the Police Act and Regulations, Code of Professional Conduct and Discipline as well as the adopted Use of Force Model and Minister's Directives. This was also noted on last year's review and while Chief Sutherland advises that it has been done there is no documented proof that it was as required.

Training

At the time of the review all training was current however there was one instance where it was not reflected in the Report of Police Officer's Training. This will be updated by the Chief.

Identification Cards

Officers are carrying their identification cards for production on demand as required.

Recommendation:

1. That immediate steps be taken by Kensington Police Services to create an acknowledgement form to document that appointees have been provided with copies of the Police Act and Regulations and reasonable steps have been taken to ensure the appointee has reviewed and understood them. *Chief Sutherland advises that this has been done and will be reviewed with all police officers.
