Overall there was an excellent level of documented compliance with Ministerial Directives.

The full time officer reviewed was hired prior to the Police Act being proclaimed in 2010 and, while not required, most documents were on file and available for review.

The part time officer's file had all required documents with the exception of his ID card. He was only with KPS a short time and left for employment with another police service at which time his KPS ID card was destroyed. As this officer was hired after the new security screening directive was issued compliance was reviewed and found to be complete and well documented.
