Summary:

Appointment

Overall there is an excellent level of documented compliance with all Ministerial Directives on appointments.

Training

A review of the two identified files and the training report provided by Chief Sutherland identified that one officer had their firearm certification and conducted energy weapon certification expire in November of 2018. Chief Sutherland advises he is aware of this and has re-certification scheduled for Feb. 19, 2019. It was also identified that one other full time officer had their conducted energy weapon and emergency vehicle/pursuit training lapse in 2018.

Chief Sutherland is in the process of having one of his officers certified as a CEW instructor which will allow for more timely training in this area.

Identification Cards

Officers are carrying their identification cards for production on demand as required.

Recommendation:

- 1. Recognizing that for a number of legitimate reasons training may not be completed when originally scheduled that, when at all possible, training be planned and take place in the early part of the calendar year. This would allow for training in the fall to make up any shortcomings.
- 2. That all identified lapsed training and re-certification be updated as soon as possible.
