### **Appointment:**

Appointment records are comprehensive and accurate demonstrating excellent compliance with Ministerial Directives.

### Training:

Overall training records are very well kept and current. One instructing officer had their certification in Domestic Violence expire due to the fact training was not offered in 2018. Another instructing officer had their Use of Force and Emergency Vehicle Operation / Pursuit expire November 2018

### **Recommendations:**

1. That all identified lapsed training and re-certification be updated as soon as possible.
